Untreated emeralds

The formation of emeralds in nature is related to tectonic events affecting the rock in which the emerald is forming. The developing emerald experiences significant mechanical strain, resulting in fissures and fractures throughout the stone. In most cases, this process lowers the transparency of the stone, depending on the number and extent of the fractures.

By filling these fissures and fractures with a foreign substance such as oil, resin or wax, the transparency of the emerald can be enhanced. Such a clarity enhancement process is usually reversible and repeatable at any time. At the time of the analysis, the emerald described in the above mentioned Gübelin Gem Lab Report did not show any indications of clarity enhancement.
