This important Mozambican ruby is distinguished by a very rare combination of size over 10 ct, a fine vivid red color variety, good brilliancy and transparency.

Analytical and advanced testing traces the origin of this gemstone to the mines of Mozambique, the mining area currently producing the largest and most significant rubies. The fascinating internal world of classic Mozambican ruby inclusions can be clearly witnessed in this particular gemstone. At the time of testing, it was concluded that the gemstone was thermally enhanced.

The combination of good attributes that this ruby displays was concluded to be important. This vivid red Mozambique ruby is reminiscent in color saturation of "GRS-type pigeon's blood ruby" (without strong fluorescence). The vivid red color radiates harmoniously in tone and color saturation. A high degree of lapidary craftsmanship adds value to the nature of this gemstone.

Rubies of this size and quality are rare.


