PORTRAIT OF ONE IMPORTANT 10.05 CT “PIGEON’S BLOOD” RUBY

GRS Laboratories examined a 10.05 ct natural ruby, described in report number GRS2022-082930, that demonstrates very good characteristics worthy of a dedicated mention.

This important ruby is distinguished by a very rare combination of size, a fine vivid to deep red color variety, good transparency, good clarity, and a large face-up appearance.

Analytical and advanced testing traces the origin of this gemstone to the mines of Mozambique, the mining area currently producing the largest and most significant rubies. The fascinating internal world of classic Mozambican ruby inclusions can be clearly witnessed in this particular gemstone. At the time of testing, it was concluded that the gemstone was thermally enhanced.

The combination of very good attributes that this ruby displays was concluded to be important. This vivid to deep red Mozambique ruby is reminiscent in color saturation of “GRS-type pigeon’s blood ruby” (without strong fluorescence). The vivid to deep red color radiates harmoniously in tone and color saturation. A high degree of lapidary craftsmanship adds value to the nature of this gemstone.

Rubies of this size and quality are very rare.
